

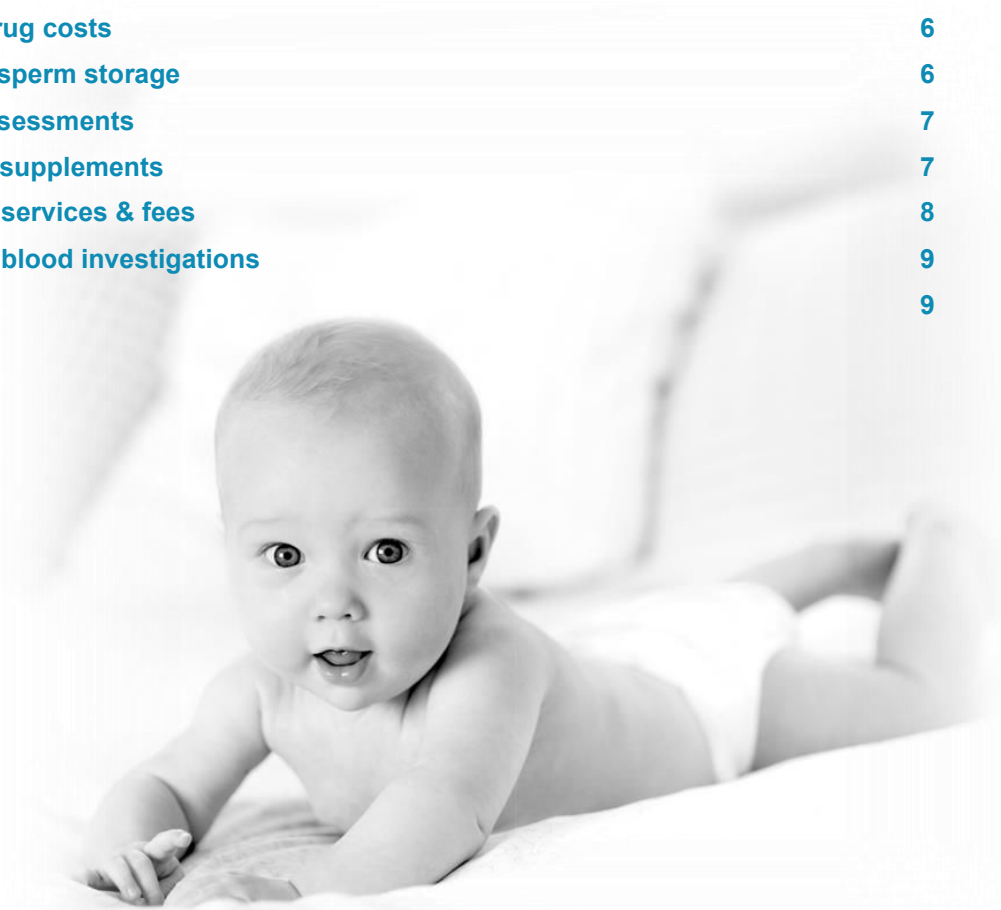

1. New Patient – Initial Fees

Before a detailed consultation can take place, it is recommended that all new patients have baseline fertility investigations carried out before seeing a consultant. This enables your consultant to accurately discuss the most appropriate treatment option for you, giving you the best chance of having a baby. This also minimises any delays to starting treatment and reduces the overall cost to you.

Pre-Treatment Packages:

- **Heterosexual Couples Package**
Includes: Pre-consultation investigations; Anti-Mullerian Hormone (AMH) blood test, detailed semen evaluation, trans vaginal pelvic scan with antral follicle count, BMI assessment & a consultation with one of our highly experienced fertility consultants. £500
- **Same Sex (Female) Package**
Includes: Pre-consultation investigations; Anti-Mullerian Hormone (AMH) blood test x 2, trans vaginal pelvic scan with antral follicle count x 2, BMI assessments x 2 & a consultation with one of our highly experienced fertility consultants. *Should only one lady be having treatment, please refer to the “Single Women Package” for pricing.* £600
- **Single Women Package**
Includes: Pre-consultation investigations; Anti-Mullerian Hormone (AMH) blood test, trans vaginal pelvic scan with antral follicle count, BMI assessment & a consultation with one of our highly experienced fertility consultants. £360
- **Same Sex (Male) Package** POA
As requirements can differ from couple to couple, please contact us for details and pricing.

2. Consultation Fees

New Patient Private Consultation (included in pre-treatment packages)	£250
Follow up Consultation When arranging a pre-treatment package, a follow up consultation is not normally needed. However, depending on the results of investigations, some patients may require a further consultation.	£170

3. Individual Pre-Treatment Fees

Most patients will require the below investigations before treatment can commence, although not all patients will require all. Investigations marked * are included in the pre-treatment packages above. If other, non-routine, investigations are required, these will be discussed with you during your consultation.

4. IVF Treatment

All our treatment fees include the HFEA fee but exclude Embryo Glue (£225), unless otherwise stated. If you wish to opt out of using Embryo Glue, please inform the admin team when calling to start your treatment and this will not be added to your invoice. Although recommended, fees do not include the use of the EmbryoScope Incubator (£995) – the benefits of this will be discussed with you during your consultation.

IVF*# per cycle of IVF, including HFEA fee, treatment planning with one of our fertility nurses, mock embryo transfer (if required), monitoring scans, in-treatment blood tests, sperm preparation, egg collection (with conscious sedation or local anaesthetic), embryo creation, culture to blastocyst++ and fresh embryo transfer, pregnancy scan, post-treatment review consultation and up to 3 support counselling sessions. **£4,400**

ICSI Supplement per cycle of IVF with Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection - excluding potential costs associated with sperm retrieval eg PESA/TESA. **£1,400**

Frozen Embryo Transfer* per FET cycle, including HFEA fee, treatment planning with one of our fertility nurses, monitoring scans, embryo thaw, embryo transfer, pregnancy scan, post treatment review and support counselling. **£2,775**

Embryo Glue (Added to the cost of treatment and used as part of the embryo transfer process unless you choose to opt out) **£225**

*Treatment costs are exclusive of the cost of drugs.

If a fresh treatment cycle results in a 'Freeze All' for medical reasons, there will be no charge for the subsequent Frozen Embryo Transfer, however embryo freeze and storage (for up to 2 years) fees of £1250 will become due.

++ Blastocyst culture is an important part of your treatment cycle; some clinics charge an additional £500 or more for this.

5. Fertility Preservation

Egg Freezing & Storage* - per cycle of IVF including HFEA fee, monitoring scans, egg retrieval and preparation for freeze, egg freezing and storage for up to 2 years. **£4,700**

Frozen Embryo Transfer after Egg Thaw – including HFEA fee monitoring scans, thaw, ICSI, embryo transfer, early pregnancy scan/follow up consultation. **£4,075**

Embryo Preservation*# per cycle of IVF including HFEA fee, monitoring scans, egg retrieval, embryo creation, culture to blastocyst, embryo freeze and storage for up to 5 years. **£5,245**

Frozen Embryo Transfer after embryo thaw – including HFEA fee, monitoring scans, embryo thaw, embryo transfer, early pregnancy scan/follow up consultation. **£2775**

Egg / Embryo Storage (per subsequent year) **£400**

* Costs are exclusive of the cost of drugs and pre-treatment consultations/investigations.

If IVF with ICSI is required, there is an additional charge of £1400.

6. Treatment Involving Insemination

Intra-uterine insemination – IUI(H) (using partner's sperm) * **£1,290**

Intra-uterine insemination – IUI(D) (including 1 ampoule of donor sperm from our clinic) *# **£2,740**

Donor Sperm – per additional ampoule when using a donor from our clinic#

7. Treatment using Donor Embryos, Eggs & Sperm

All of our treatment fees include the HFEA fee but exclude Embryo Glue, unless otherwise stated. If you wish to opt out of using Embryo Glue, please inform the admin team when calling to start your treatment and this will not be added to your invoice.

If donor sperm is required a supplement of £250 plus the cost of sperm at £1200 per ampoule will be payable.

Should a known donor request expenses an additional charge, of up to £985, will be payable by the recipient.

8. Sharing Arrangements

Sperm Sharing – significantly reduced cost treatment in which the male partner donates his sperm for the use of other fertility patients whilst having his own fertility treatment. A separate information and pricing leaflet is available for Sperm Sharing, please contact us for a copy POA

Egg Sharing - significantly reduced cost treatment in which the female partner donates her eggs for the use of other fertility patient whilst having her own fertility treatment. A separate information and pricing leaflet is available for Egg Sharing and Egg Sharing in a Shared Motherhood cycle, please contact us for a copy POA

9. Surrogacy

10. Surgical Sperm Retrieval

Some investigations, procedures and consultations with a urologist are not arranged by Hull & East Riding Fertility and excluded from our charging structure.

11. Average Drug Costs

The cost of drugs can vary significantly from patient to patient. The costs outlined below are therefore based on an average cost per patient. When you commence your treatment at Hull & East Riding Fertility, we will be able to give you a more tailored estimate of these costs.

12. Embryo & Sperm Storage Fees

13. Fertility Assessments

All of our assessments include a full consultation and treatment plan (if appropriate)

Female assessment – including AMH, trans vaginal ultrasound scan (with antral follicle count), BMI assessment and results consultation.	£360
Male assessment – including semen analysis, anti-sperm antibody testing and results consultation.	£350
Heterosexual couple’s assessment – including AMH, BMI assessment, trans vaginal ultrasound scan with antral follicle count, semen analysis with anti-sperm antibody testing and results consultation.	£500
Same sex (female) couple’s assessment AMH, BMI assessment, trans vaginal ultrasound scan with antral follicle count for both partners and results consultation. <i>Should only one lady be having treatment, please refer to Female Assessment for pricing.</i>	£600

Please be aware that further investigations may be required, depending on individual circumstances, before a treatment cycle can be planned.

14. Treatment Supplements

The supplements below incur additional fees to that of a standard treatment cycle. These supplements are not suitable for all patients. Should you or your consultant feel there is a benefit to any of the below being added to your treatment cycle, this should be discussed during your consultation.

Artificial Oocyte Activation (AOA)	£195
AOA is a technique used to improve fertilization rates in couples who have experienced failed or low fertilisation in previous ICSI cycles. AOA involves using a substance like calcium ionophore to artificially trigger the egg's activation, increasing calcium within the egg and potentially enhancing fertilisation.	
Embryo Glue	£225
EmbryoGlue is not an actual glue, but it acts like glue by increasing the chance of implantation of the embryo to the womb. It consists of a high concentration of hyaluronan and recombinant human albumin, both of which promote implantation	
EmbryoScope Triple Select	£995
A 3-dimensional time-lapse imaging system enabling enhanced information about embryo development to be collected for refinement of embryo selection. A powerful embryo grading system that harnesses clinical expertise and artificial intelligence (AI) to select the best embryo for transfer and to optimise your chances of success.	
Endometrial Receptivity Testing:	
Endometrial receptivity testing involves taking a biopsy of the endometrial lining of the uterus and testing the tissue to see which genes are expressed. When combined with a computational predictor these results indicate when the endometrium may be most receptive to an embryo implanting. The below fees include a follow up consultation to discuss results.

Endometrial scratch	£300
An endometrial scratch is a procedure where a small, sterile plastic tube is used to gently scratch the lining of the uterus (endometrium). It is performed before IVF treatment and may increase the chances of implantation by triggering the body's healing response, which may make the endometrium more receptive to an embryo.	
Physiological intracytoplasmic sperm injection (PICSI)	£340
PICSI technique used to select sperm to use in ICSI treatment. It involves placing sperm with hyaluronic acid (HA), a natural compound found in the body. PICSI identifies sperm that can bind to HA and these sperm are selected for use in treatment. <i>(Fee is additional to the ICSI supplement)</i>	
SIS procedure	£450
Saline infusion sonohysterogram (SIS) is a procedure to evaluate the lining of the uterus and shape of the uterine cavity. A regular transvaginal ultrasound can pick up many uterine abnormalities, however, more subtle defects which may impact reproduction may be better evaluated with SIS.	
Sperm DNA fragmentation testing (include a follow up consultation but do not include a standard semen evaluation which is charged separately)	
A sperm DNA fragmentation test assesses the condition of sperm DNA, specifically looking for damage or fragmentation that can affect male fertility. It can be used to evaluate sperm health beyond what a standard semen analysis provides. Your consultant will help to identify the most appropriate test.	
EXACT test	£760
EXTEND test	£895
Zymot Test	£250
A Zymot test is a sperm selection process. This test selects sperm with better morphology (shape) and motility and helps to isolate sperm with lower levels of DNA fragmentation, reducing the risk of using low-quality sperm in fertility treatment.

16. Payment & Refunds

Treatment invoices will be sent to you, in accordance with your Cost of Treatment Plan, and are due for payment in full prior to the start of your treatment cycle. Charges for pre-treatment investigations, and all other services, are due for payment 48 hours prior to your appointment date. Preferred payment methods are by credit/debit card or bank transfer; however, cheque and cash transactions are accepted. Appointments cancelled with less than 48 hours' notice will be charged at the full price and no refund offered.

For our patients' convenience, we partner with Fertility2U, a homecare pharmacy provider who specialise in fertility medication dispensing and delivery. The majority of your treatment drugs will be dispensed and delivered by Fertility2u; payment needs to be made to them directly. Drugs that are dispensed directly from the clinic, e.g. top up drugs, must be paid for before being dispensed. Unfortunately, due to UK legislation, any drugs that are dispensed to a patient are non-returnable.

Once a treatment cycle has commenced and there is a need to cancel or abandon the cycle, either a restart fee or refund will be calculated to the point of which the cancellation/abandonment or restart occurred.

If the use of our Embryoscope incubator is cancelled more than 48 hours prior to egg collection, a full refund of the cost will be made, if cancellation of this service is less than 48 hours prior to egg collection the refund will be less £150.
